PIZZA MARGHERITA

POUR 4 personnes | **PRÉPARATION 30 minutes** | **REPAS 1 heure** | **CUISSON 10 à 15 minutes**

INGRÉDIENTS

- 1 pâte à pizza fraîche ou surgelée
- 1 boîte de tomates concassées
- 1 cuillère à soupe d'huile d'olive
- 8 tranches de jambon
- 1 cuillère à soupe

UTENSILES

- 1 planche de bois
- 1 four à pizza
- 1 rouleau à pâtisserie
- 1 rouleau à pâtisserie à tiges

La pizza margherita, la plus connue et la plus facile du monde ! Dès que vous aurez fait la pâte, il ne reste plus qu'à la garnir avec les ingrédients préférés de vos enfants : tomates, basilic, mozzarella, jambon, olives... C'est simple et délicieux !

Préchauffez ton four à 260°C. C'est prêt pour la plaisir de cuisiner.

① Découpe la pâte suffisante pour faire une pizza de 30 cm de diamètre. Si tu n'as pas de planche de bois, place-la dans tes mains et aide-toi en l'enroulant pour la faire tenir. Tu pourras alors la poser sur le four sans qu'il se déforme.

② Étale la pâte sur la planche de bois et étale la mozzarella dessus. Ajoute des tranches de jambon et des olives. Laisse un peu d'espace sur les bords pour pouvoir la couper.

③ Sur ta planche à découper, coupe les boules de mozzarella en tranches un peu épaisses.

④ Lave les feuilles de basilic avec un filet d'eau et secoue-les sur le papier sécheteur.

⑤ Vient la présentation : pose la pâte à pizza sur une plaque de cuisson et garnis-la avec la mozzarella, le jambon et les olives. Garnis avec les tranches de mozzarella de la planche à découper et ajoute quelques olives supplémentaires. Laisse cuire 10 à 15 minutes. Au bout de ce temps, la mozzarella sera dorée et la mozzarella fondue.

POUR 6 personnes | **PRÉPARATION 45 minutes** | **REPAS 45 minutes**

INGRÉDIENTS

- 1 kg de pomme de terre à cuire
- 1 cuillère à soupe
- 1 cuillère à soupe d'huile d'olive
- 1 cuillère à soupe de persil
- 1 cuillère à soupe de basilic

LA TOMATE

Pomme de terre à cuire, tomate à cuire, basilic, huile d'olive, persil, origan, sel et poivre.

La tomate, c'est comme un jardin sans fleurs.

① Fais cuire une grande pomme de terre à la vapeur. Lorsqu'elle est cuite, couvre-la et laisse-la refroidir.

② Pendant ce temps, lave et épique la tomate et coupe-la en deux. Retire le cœur et les graines. Ensuite, coupe-la en deux dans le sens de la longueur et dégouline deux fois de chaque côté.

③ Sort la pomme de terre cuite. Couvre-la avec un torchon et laisse-la refroidir.
